





Episode Management

Supports multiple payment and disbursement models


- Single prospective payment to administrative provider
 - Administrative provider contracts with local providers to form a center of excellence
 - A lump sum payment is made to the administrative provider who then disburses payment to other providers



- Prospective payment to multiple providers
 - Health plans contract with multiple providers to form a narrow network
 - Each provider's portion of a bundled payment is disbursed directly to providers



- Retrospective reconciliation
 - Providers paid FFS, after episode is complete analysis of performance relative to clinical and financial targets
 - Gainsharing or penalties to administrative provider recommended based on performance

Episode Management 5.1 Release

Next step in supporting evolving bundled payment model

- Episode architecture and definitions focus of initial development automated IHA, Prometheus and custom episodes
- Deployed based logic rules through health plan pilots to identify, categorize and recommend appropriate episode payment at the claim line level
- 5.1 release
 - Enhanced rule performance and visualization of episode details
 - Integration with Reimbursement Manager to price claim based on provider specific rate schedules
 - Additional standard reports to support implementation and management of episodes
 - Interactive dashboards to help identify high and low performing providers and areas for improvement in utilization, cost, leakage and complications
- Episode Management can be utilized to support bundled payment automation in pilots or full scale programs
