

Just For Us


- 350 patients since 2000
- Average age 70, multiple chronic conditions
- 44% have mental illness
- All are home-bound
- 84% African-American; many with low to no family support
- Low literacy or illiterate

Outcomes:



All patients with hypertension $79\% \leq 140/90$
Diabetics with hypertension $84\% \leq 140/90$
