

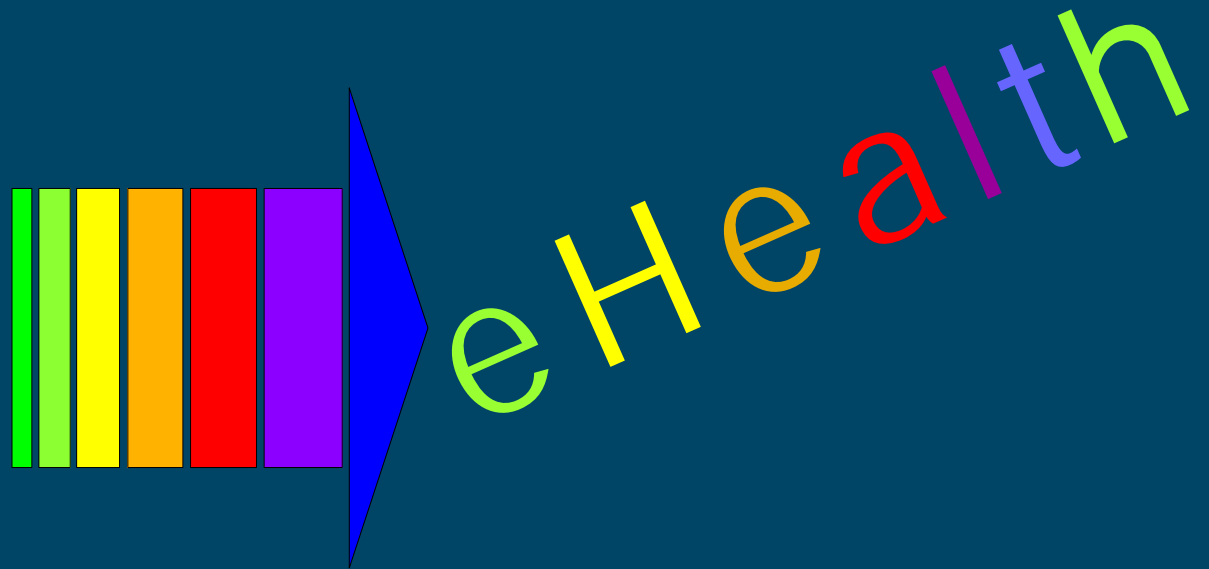

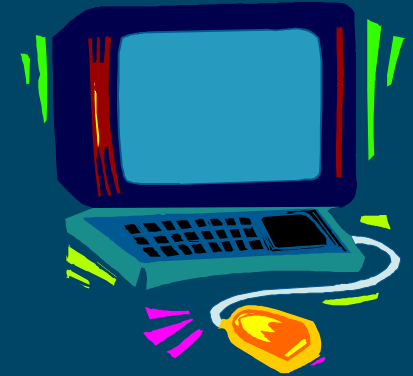
IDX eHealth Tools

- Enhances an organization's security infrastructure to meet the demands of web based and/internet enabled environments.



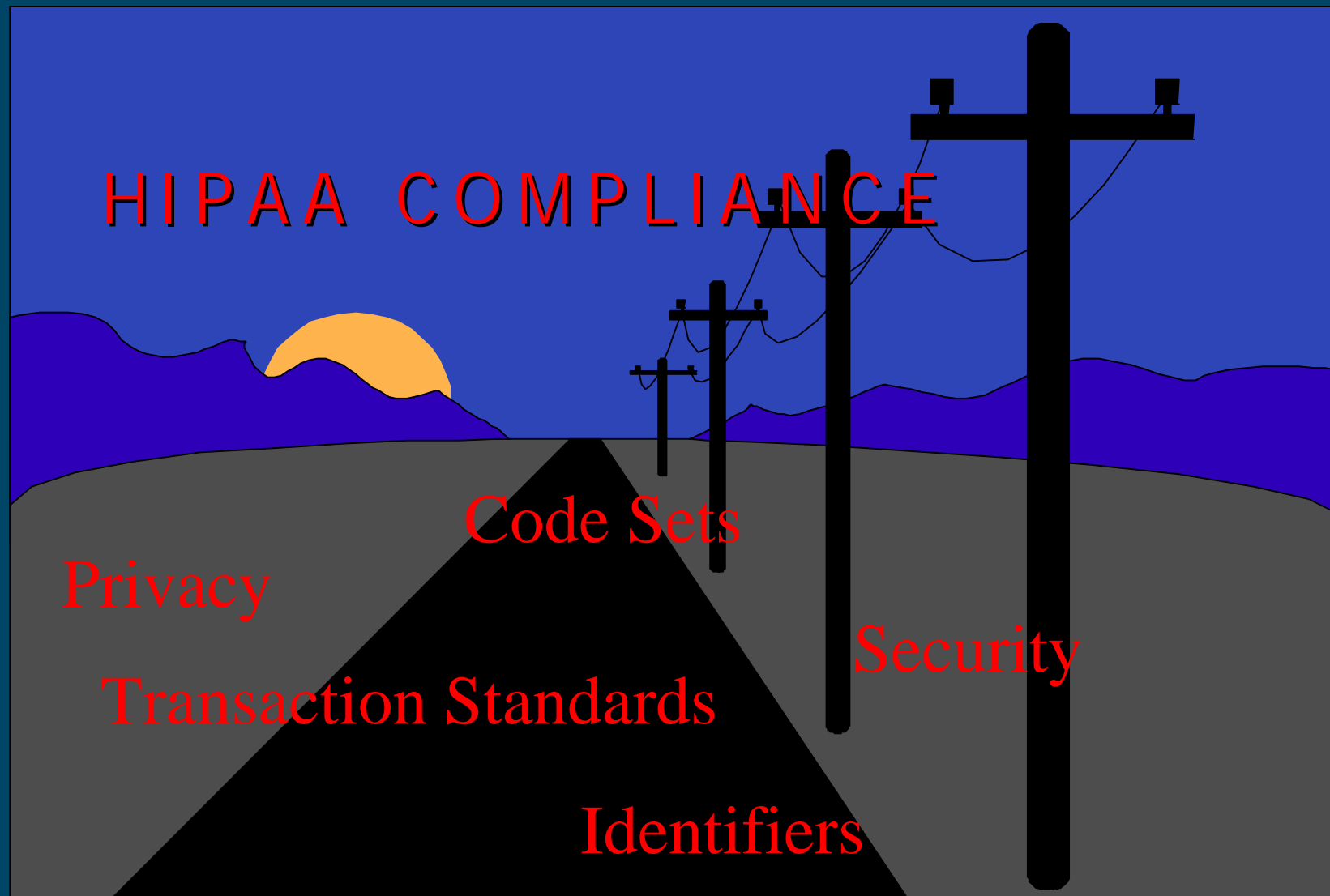

National Health Plan Identifier	1st Qtr 2001	4 Qtr/2002?
Claims Attachment Trans	1st Qtr 2001	4th Qtr 2002?
National Individual Identifier	<i>All dates on Hold</i>	<i>All dates on Hold</i>

The first Implementation Date is October 16, 2002.
