Why WEDI created the HIPAA Success Task Group?



■ The Secretary may modify an initial standard at any time during the first year of adoption, if she determines that the modification is necessary to permit compliance with the standard.

[45 CFR Parts 160 and 162, page 50313]

Why WEDI created the HIPAA Success Task Group?



- WEDI is a consultant to the Secretary named in the HIPAA legislation
- Some regulatory changes might reduce implementation costs
- Other regulatory changes might facilitate timely implementation


How is the Success Task Group different from WEDI-SNIP?



- The Task Group identifies obstacles to timely HIPAA implementation or successful implementation efforts and recommends regulatory modifications if necessary
- WEDI-SNIP develops industry collaboration and implementation processes for HIPAA regulations as promulgated

What testimony was provided?



- Issues that could represent a considerable financial burden and suggestions for mitigation
- Issues that could not be resolved by the current implementation dates
- Issues that cannot be resolved and suggestions for modification
- Successes



- For institutional providers, payers, fiscal intermediaries and others, there is no benefit yet enormous cost associated with implementing NDC codes on claims
- Removal of all National Drug Code qualifiers from the SV2 segment of the institutional health care claim implementation guide



- The business need to submit an electronic inquiry for pricing proposed dental services is not met in the final rule.
- Designate the 837 Health Care Claim: Dental as the appropriate transaction for the request for pre-determination of dental benefits



- NCPDP Batch Standard Version 1.1 is the correct version to be used with Telecommunication Version 5.1
- The request is to clarify the rule by changing the named NCPDP Batch Standard to Version 1.1 in all appropriate places



- WEDI supports privacy legislation that pre-empts state law to provide a consistent national privacy policy
- WEDI supports legislation extending the definition of covered entities to all organizations with access to protected health information
