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What Is HIPAA GIVES?

- HIPAA Program/Project

Goals:

- Establish an information clearinghouse via a national web site for exchanging individual state deliverables for HIPAA-related projects, such as:
 - Budget frameworks
 - Program Management Office (PMO) structure
 - Assessment tools
 - Work Plan templates
 - Sample policy and procedures, etc.
- Provide a forum via FAQs, conference calls, etc. for states to discuss and resolve issues related to HIPAA implementation.

Preliminary Activities:

- Solicited a core group of state government entities to establish and maintain this service.
- Organized an initial conference call with the core group to review and finalize the vision, mission/goals and determine timeline.
- Defined roles and responsibilities of participants.

Preliminary Activities (cont'd):

- Developed a project plan for completing deliverables, including:
 - √ An initial list of requirements to be addressed by the national web site.
 - √ The access methods and audience for the national web site.
 - √ Planning, building, and managing the web site (under development).
 - √ A schedule for ongoing communication among participating states.
 - √ A communication strategy to promote awareness and utilization of the service.
