31% of adults prefer to be contacted via text over voice (Pew, Sept.2011)


Wireless devices in the U.S. now outnumber people (CNN, Oct.2011)

Texting has infiltrated all aspects of our work and personal communication.


Consumerization of I.T.: 95% of I.T. use self purchased technology for work (IDC, 2010)

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### The Compliance Problem with SMS

#### Why standard SMS is **NOT** secure

- 4 copies created for every text message sent
- Messages forwarded/copied without permission
- Each message lives forever in clear text
  - HIPAA Security Rule Requires Patient Notification if unsecured data loss
- Devices/Sensitive Information can be lost/stolen.

Among HIPAA breaches reported, 75% have been electronic and 25% paper-based\*
