**Cloud Computing Is:  
The Use of Services and Applications,  
Including the Storage of Data, Hosted  
Remotely from the User and Accessed  
Through the Internet.**

## **Health Care Concerns for Cloud Computing**

- 1. Access to Data; Back-up  
Disaster Recovery/Business Continuity**
- 2. Required and Addressable Controls**

  - **Technical Safeguards**
- 4. PHI In Motion/At Rest**

## **Cloud Computing Federal Rules to Address:**

**Security: The Overwhelming Issue is whether and how the information is secured in motion or at rest.**

**Privacy Rules are Important, but apply to the Covered Entity or other Cloud User, Not to the Use of the Cloud. In other words, you need to comply regardless of the location of the PHI.**

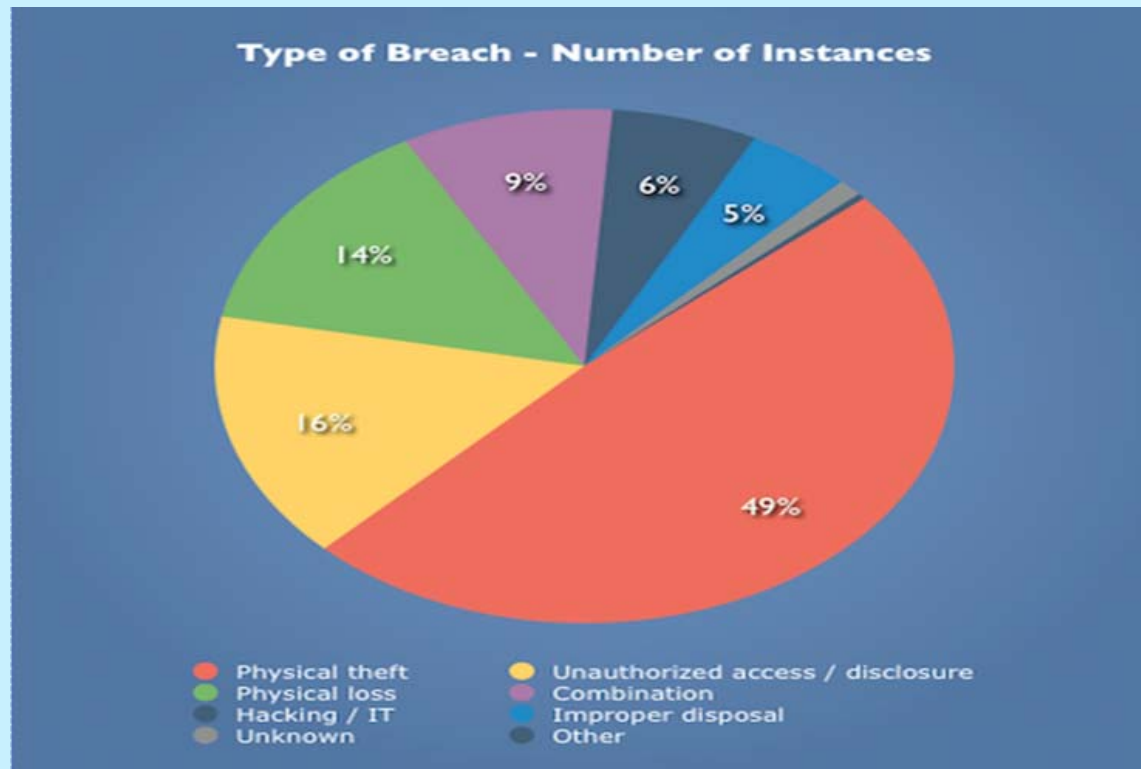
