

## Future of Healthcare

- Goal: Best Care at Lower Cost (Sept. 2012 IOM Report)
- Means: Clinician/Patient direct interaction with Clinical Decision Support System (CDSS) ("Meaningful Use")
  - In a continuously learning healthcare system.
- Enablers: EHR + HIE + CDSS (=> SAVES LIVES and \$\$\$)
- Requires:
  - Interoperability with sources of clinical data and sources of computable rules for best clinical practices (Standards).
  - <u>Incentives</u> to incorporate HIT into healthcare practice (Resources and Regulations).
  - Investigations of systemic failures to enable systems that detect and prevent errors through best practices at the point of decision making (Research).
  - Trust through interoperable security and privacy (including patient consent).
