## *Some Possible Areas of Discussion...*

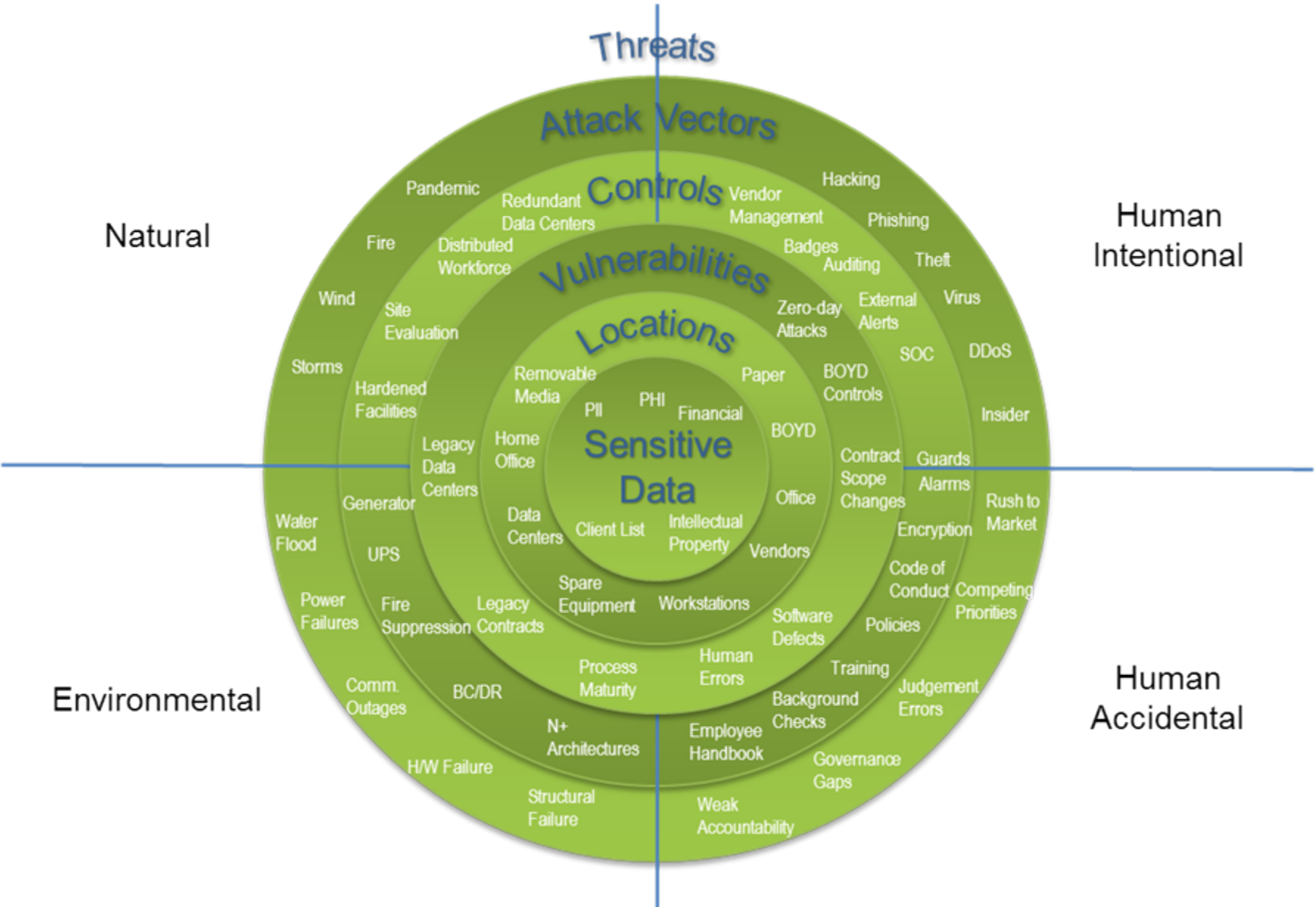
- **Compliance does not equal Security**

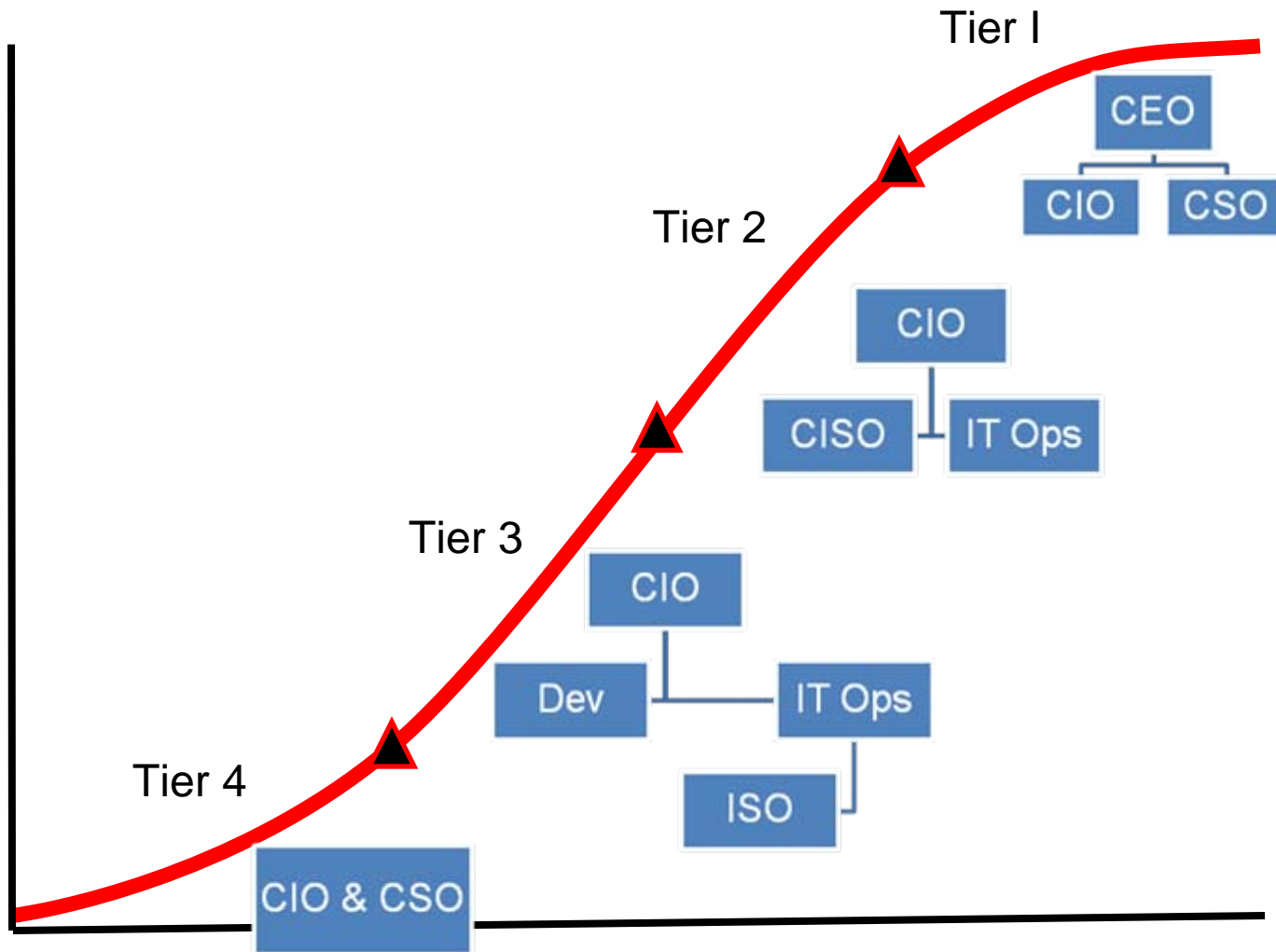
