
Current HIPAA Policy Initiatives



Breaches Reported Involving Hacking/IT Incidents






500+ Breaches by Type


September 23, 2009 through December 31, 2018

January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018






Breaches Reported Involving Stolen Laptops


Breaches Reported Involving Email Accounts





September 23, 2009 through December 31, 2018




January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018
