
Sutter Health (Before 1995)

Hospital Company




Sutter Health (After 1995)




We're Creating Northern California's Finest Health Care Network

- 24 Fundraising organizations; \$60-\$80 million raised each year









Growing Contribution by Medical Foundations


Sutter Health net operating revenue (in millions) 2000 - 2008






Our New Region Structure


