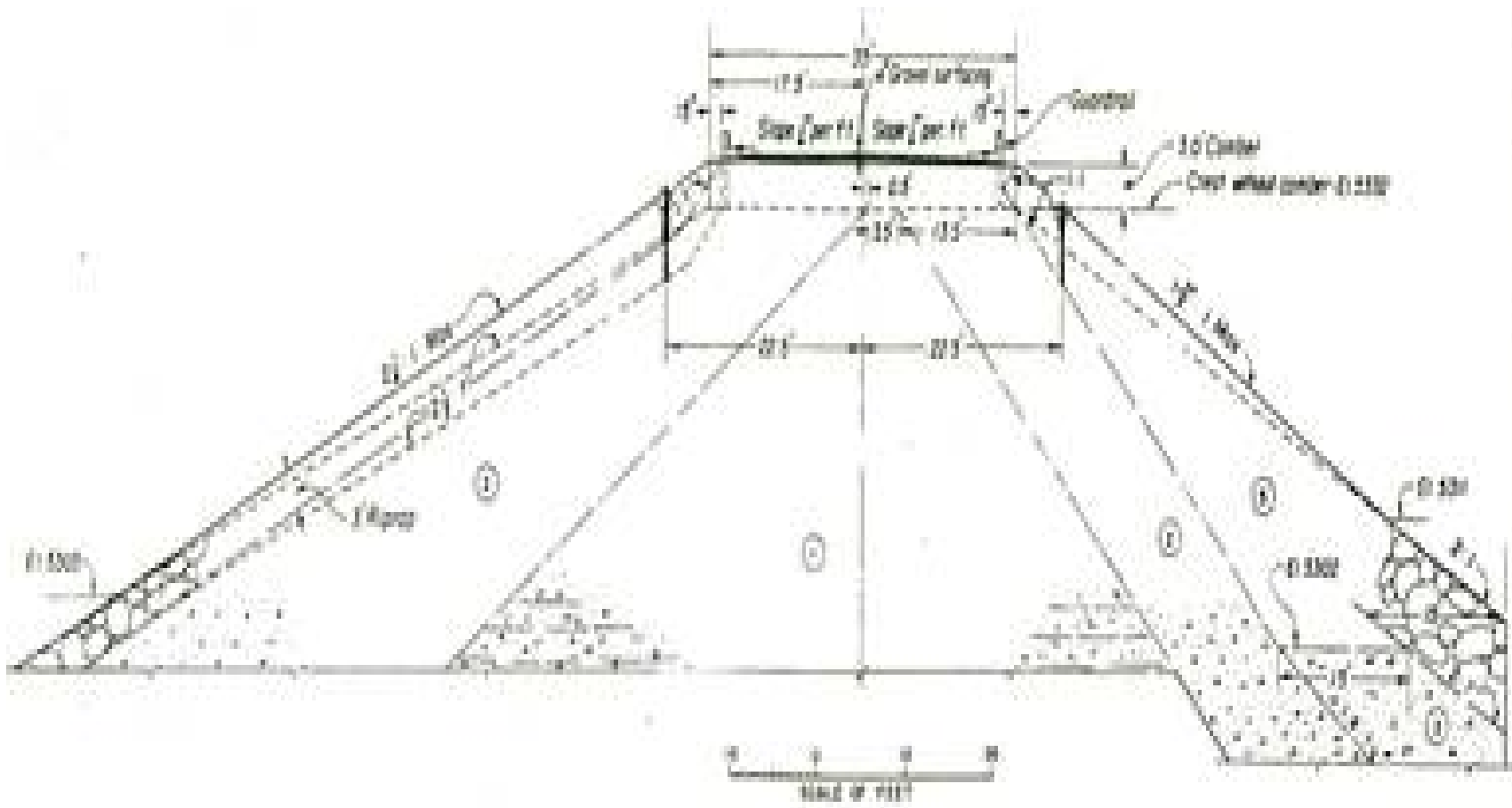


Water flows downhill – and toward money

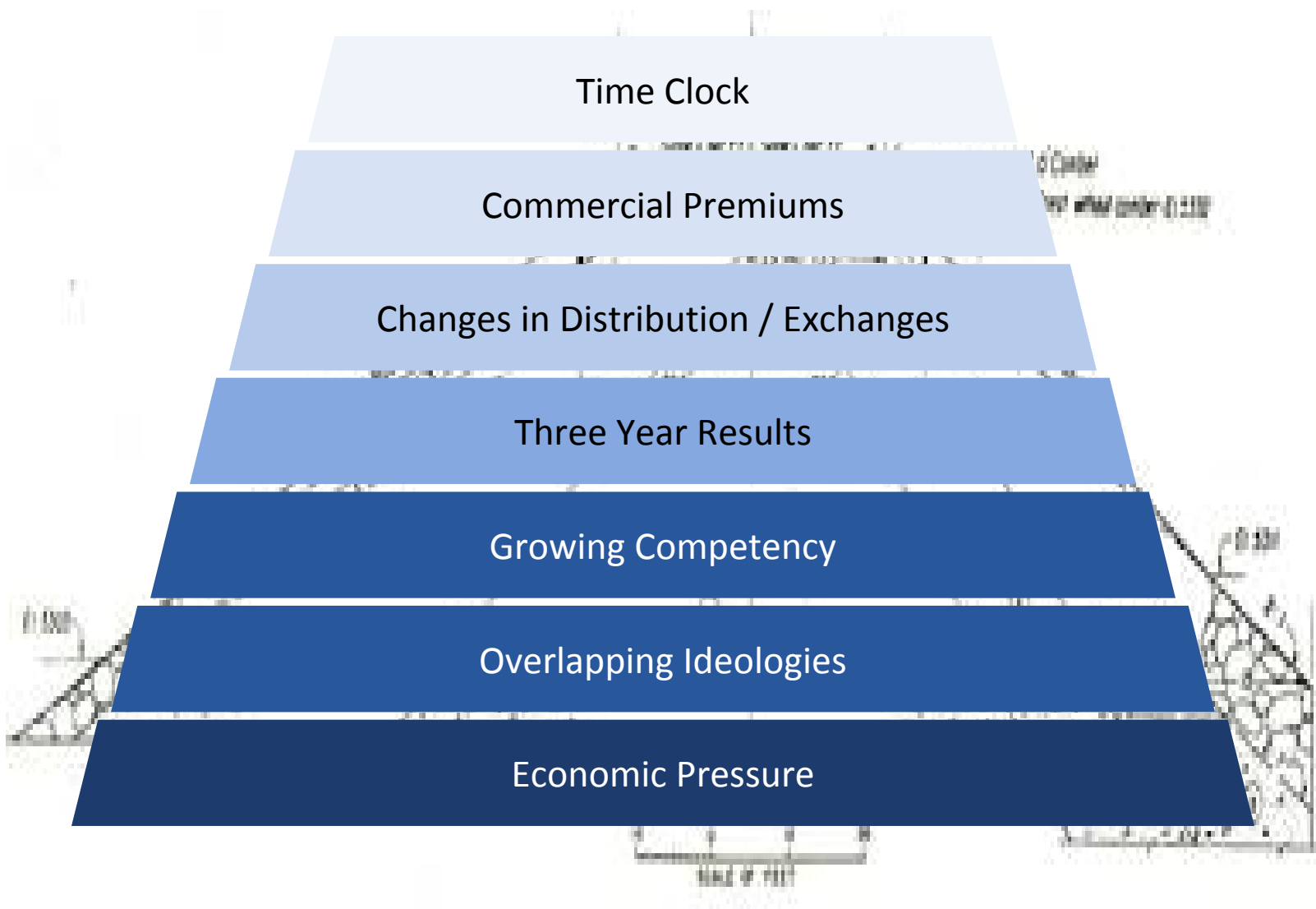
