
Removal Of Non Clinical Barriers Is Required To Prevent Condition Escalation



- The Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) embraces patient and family as a crucial concept for improving health outcomes and quality.
- The social support system of a patient is a key factor in defining their risk of readmission.
- Hospital costs were 24 percent higher for socially isolated individuals than for socially connected individuals with an equivalent level of clinical risk.
- People follow the treatment advice of friends and family 86% of the time.
- 84% of health care spending is attributed to 50% of the non-institutionalized population that has one or more chronic conditions.
- 17% of patients with chronic conditions received conflicting information from providers.
- Every \$25 increase in home-delivered meals for older adults is associated with at 1% decline in nursing home admissions.
- There are at least 39,000,000 non-clinical caregivers in the US.¹ This includes 7,000,000 -10,000,000 adult children supporting parents from long distance.²
