## The Impact Of Corporate Compliance On Corporate External Relations:

Mergers and Acquisitions

- May be a decisive or important factor to a potential acquirer;
- May be required for M & A deal completion.

• New Business Development

Often arises in context of RFPs and/or RFIs;
Often a term or provision in public contracts.

- Risk Management and Loss Control
- Integral part of E & O and D & O insurance underwriting and/or pricing;
- May be mandatory to receive certain coverages.

## The Impact Of Corporate Compliance On Corporate External Relations (cont'd):

## Litigation

- Sets a positive tone in portraying company to a fact finder or judge when company is a defendant;
- Often facilitates settlement with regulators.

- Physical Plant/Property Management
- International Applications

- Environmental protection programs;

- Often addresses health and safety issues.
