



- 32 Medical Centers








## **Kaiser Permanente At-a-Glance (continued)**

#### Cover your cough.

Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze, or cough or sneeze into your upper sleeve, not your hands.

Toss your used tissue in the waste basket.

#### Wear a mask if asked.


We may ask you to put on a surgical mask to protect others.

#### Clean your hands after coughing or sneezing.

Wash your hands with soap and water or clean them with an alcohol-based hand rub.

  - Reinforce hand and respiratory hygiene

- Please ask the receptionist for a mask or tissues.

## On-Going Member Education & Assistance

- Member of the State of California Department of Public Health Pandemic Influenza Vaccine and Antiviral Advisory Group
- Presented at the Institute of Medicine's Committee on Antiviral Medication Strategies for an Influenza Pandemic in January 2008
- Began preliminary discussion with federal health partners to conduct a project demonstrating the feasibility of dispensing an antiviral medkit to Kaiser Permanente members in advance of a pandemic
- Kaiser Permanente's Electronic Health Record was successfully leveraged during the Southern California Wildfires



## On-Going Member Education & Assistance (continued)

- Developed Kaiser Permanente specific "altered standards of care" guidelines
- Designed an employee guide to pandemic influenza "Preparing for Pandemic Influenza" and posted to our website
