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


Distribution of Average Household Spending by Medicare and Non-Medicare Households, 2010

CDHP Growth: Today and Looking Ahead

Percentage of LARGE employers that 65% expect to offer CDHPs five years from now. Percentage of ALL employers that 48% expect to offer CDHPs five years from now. Growth rate of people enrolled in 18% CDHPs in the U.S. in 2011. Percentage of small employers 22% offering CDHPs in 2011, up from 20% in 2010. CDHP enrollment as percentage of all 33% employees covered in employer-

sponsored health plans in 2011.

And There is **No Correlation** between Cost and Quality




The highest charges often come from hospitals with the lowest quality ratings for the associated procedure.


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Two Kinds of Transparency

- Cost Transparency has good, if uneven, progress
- Information/Quality Transparency has very little progress (except for organizations like Bridges to Excellence and Leapfrog Group)



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Information Transparency: Highlighting Hospital Safety to Make Informed Decisions

- Leapfrog's Hospital Safety Score is designed to help people stay safe when admitted to the hospital, and foster clinical and quality improvement.
- Aetna is the first health plan to make the scores available within their hospital directory.

Transparency: Prescription for Change

- Federal legislation to require cost and quality transparency (currently 34 states require some form of reporting of hospital charges)
- Make available, for 3rd party data mining, identifier-sanitized claims and outcomes data from <u>all</u> sources (payers, governmental entities, plan sponsors and providers)
- Make available, for 3rd party data mining, Medicare and Medicaid physician and hospital quality data
