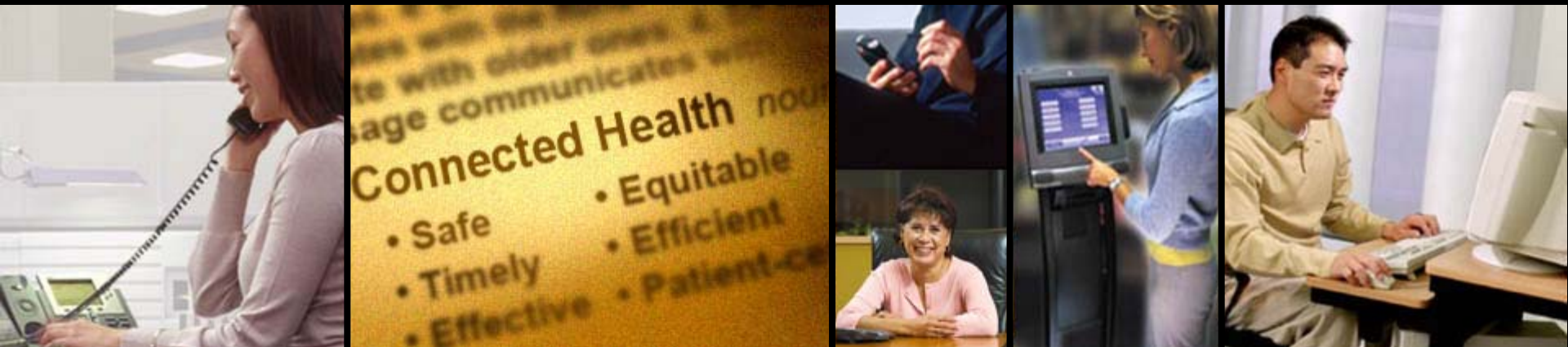

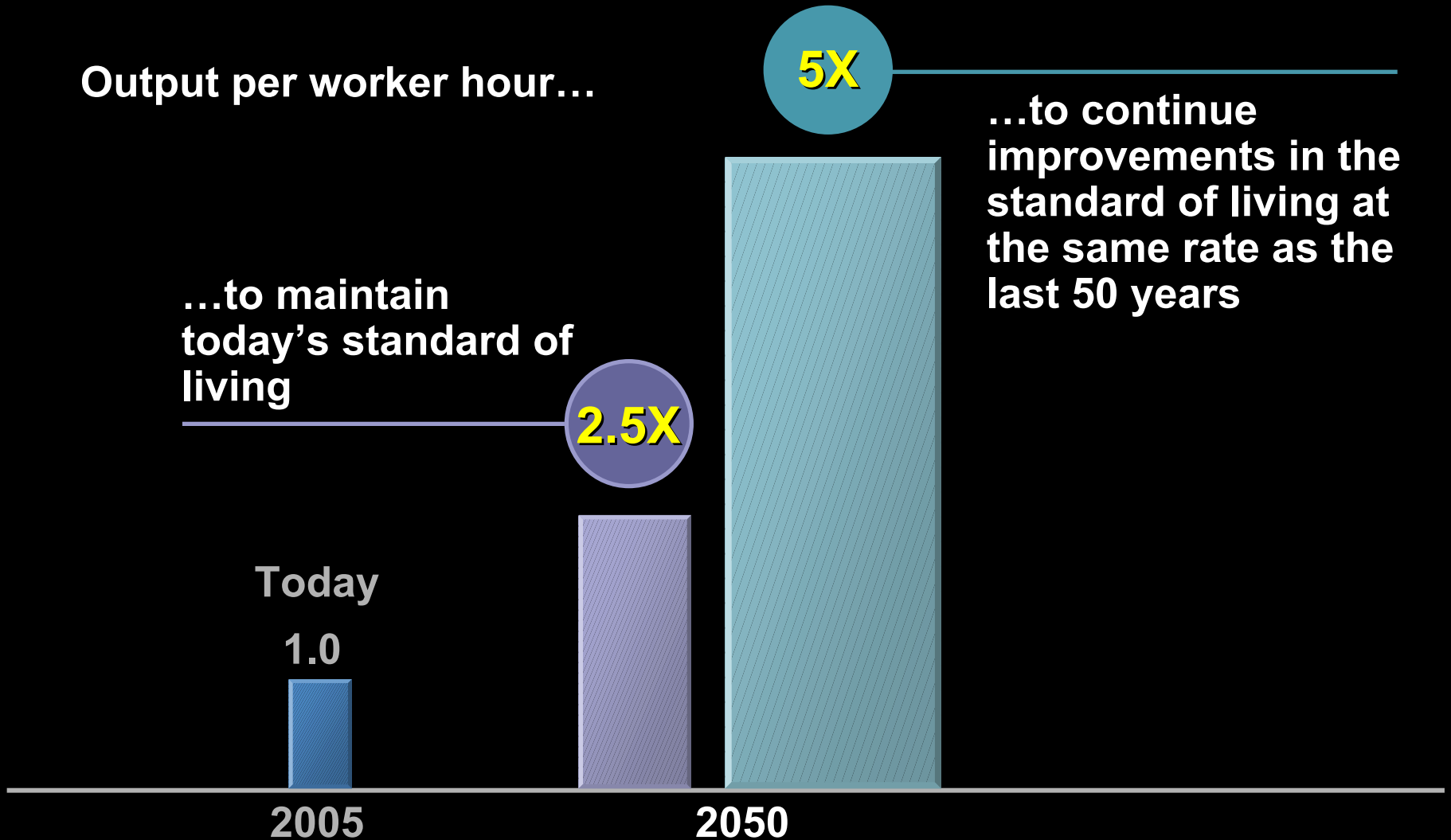

Key Messages
