- It was founded in April 1966 in Germany by Prof. Martini who invited 70 to 80 European hepatologists for a two-day symposium on hepatology and encountered a big success
- It was then decided that Meetings would be held annually with the venue rotating through different European countries

# **History**


- European Association for the Study of the Liver
- •EASL was officially registered by the Swiss Chamber of Commerce in Zurich in 1993
- •An independent office was opened in Geneva in 2009 employing 3 persons
- •In 2015, EASL is now fully in-house managed and employs 27 people



- •In April 2015, EASL celebrated its 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary at the International Liver Congress ™ in Vienna
- •In April 2015, the JHEP, Journal of Hepatology, also celebrated its 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary






