Patient Centered Medical Home Pilot

- 35,000 state employees and retirees in more than 70 practices
- Fee for service fee enhancement of 2%
- Additional fee enhancements based upon scoring of agreed upon metrics including:
 - complying with standards of care guidelines
 - reduction in ED visits
 - inpatient admissions
 - and avoidable readmissions

Results:

- 18% fewer hospital admissions
- 3% fewer avoidable ED visits
- · 29% lower readmission rate

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Health Enhancement Plan

126,274 Participants

- Required age appropriate and preventive screenings and care
- Lower-co-pays for medication/care associated with five chronic disease conditions
- Higher premiums and annual deductibles for non-compliant or non participating plan members

Results:

- 99% enrollment, 99% compliance
- ED visits down 4.3%
- Adherence to chronic disease drug regiments up between 5 and 15%
- Medical trend dropped from 8.9% to 2.2%
