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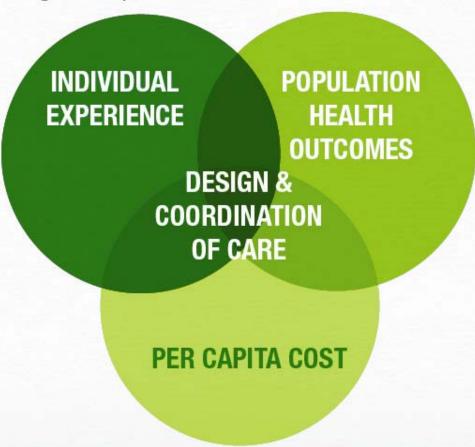
Who is Priority Health?

The supply of comprehensive ambulatory services, including prevention, acute care and chronic disease management, is at the core of efforts to address health reform.



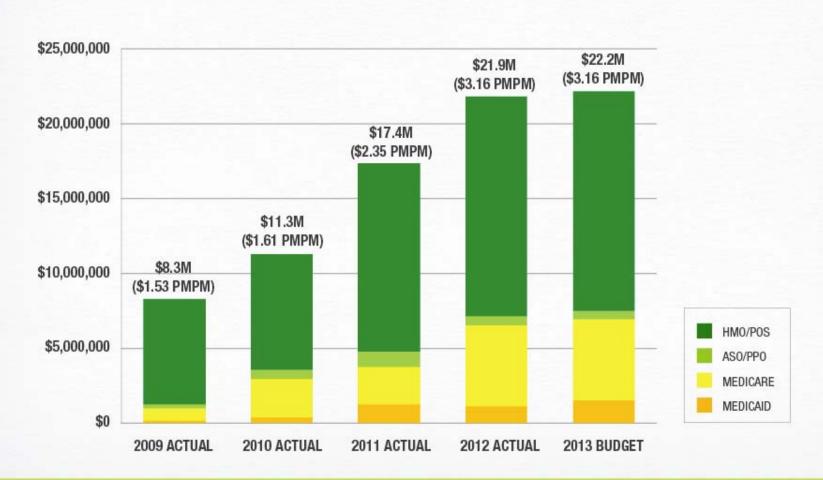

Our improved and expanded Partners in Performance (PIP) program supports delivery of excellent, high quality and cost-effective care.



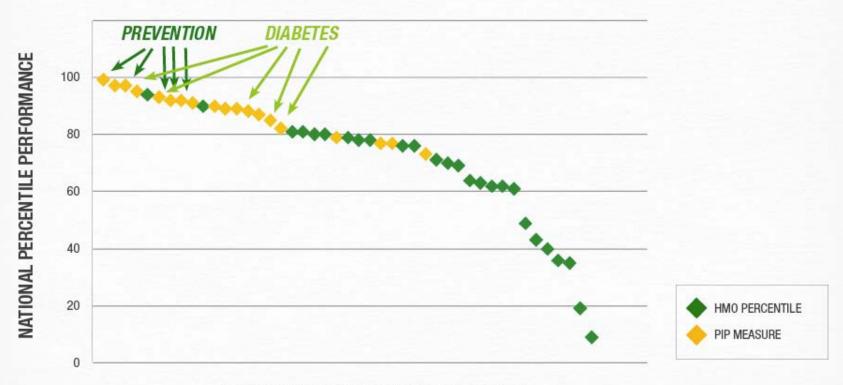
PIP incentive payments by business category



PIP incentive payments by measure category



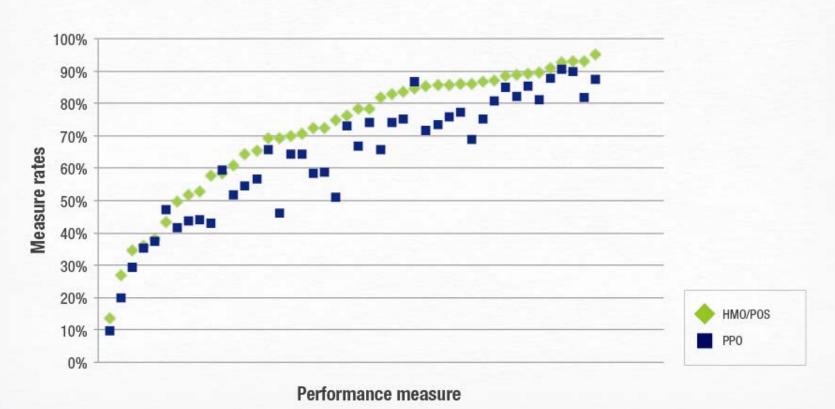

Distribution of measure performance



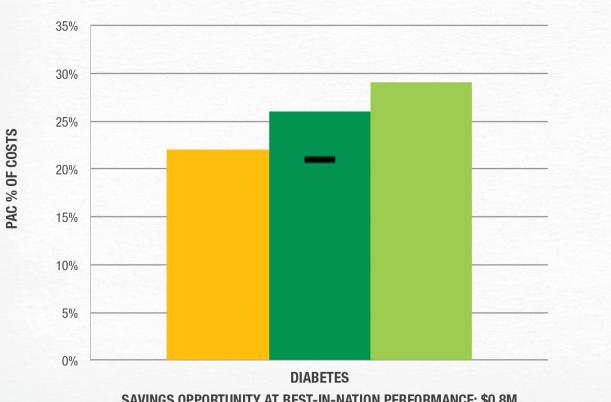

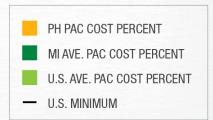

We create a purposeful, patient-centered experience



Patient experience significantly improved across practices over both survey periods.



Staff experience significantly improved across practices over both periods of the survey. Individual practices either had stable or improved trends in patient experience.



Provider experience had an initial positive trend and was stable in the second survey period.*
