
ACO in Colorado

The Template

- Divide the State into Regions
- Started Out w/ Regional Proposals to do Care Coordination for Medicaid Patients
- Regional Grantees Contracted w/ PCP's to do Care Coordination
- State Pays PCP's \$3 PMPM for Care Coord
- State Pays Regional Grantee to provide CC Support

Integrated Community Health Partners (ICHP)

- Region 4 Grantee
- Partnership of 3 FQHC's, 4 CMHC's, VO & CCMCN (Formed LLC)
- All Partners One Vote
- Currently at 50,000 Covered Medicaid Lives
- Receive \$9 PMPM for Care Coordination
 Support and Management of the Region

ICHP Moving Forward

- State Medicaid Agency Deemed the Regional ACO's as the Conduit for Payment Reform
- Application for Payment Reform Pilots Been Submitted for a 7/1/14 start
- Anticipate the ACO's Will Be the Recipients of Global Payments by 2016
- Planning for Having an Insurance License by 2015
