## Duals demonstrations represent significant transition for individuals






## Passive enrollment presents particular challenges






## Confusion will impact plans, beneficiaries, providers, etc...





# Passive enrollment threatens to disrupt care



## Passive enrollment stresses the capacity of plans, states and CMS

#### ARE THEY READY TO:

Provide new services

Meet new requirements

Handle enrollments

Measure quality

Address problems

Process information



### Addressing confusion

- Simple policy
- Timelines that don't conflict
- Clear, accessible notices
- Multiple contacts
- Funded enrollment counselors (SHIPs, ADRCs)
- Comprehensive, independent training effort



## Addressing care continuity

- Strong care continuity provisions for:
  - Access to providers
  - Access to services, supplies, treatment regimes, prescription drugs, LTSS



## Addressing readiness

- Voluntary enrollment periods
- Phased enrollment within regions and across state
- Caps on monthly enrollments
