Traditional Pay for Performance

- Medicaid only
 - As of 2006, half of states have one or more programs (Kuhmerker & Hartman 2007)
- Focus on individual measures; individual providers
- Limited scale
- Little evaluation
- The managed care challenge

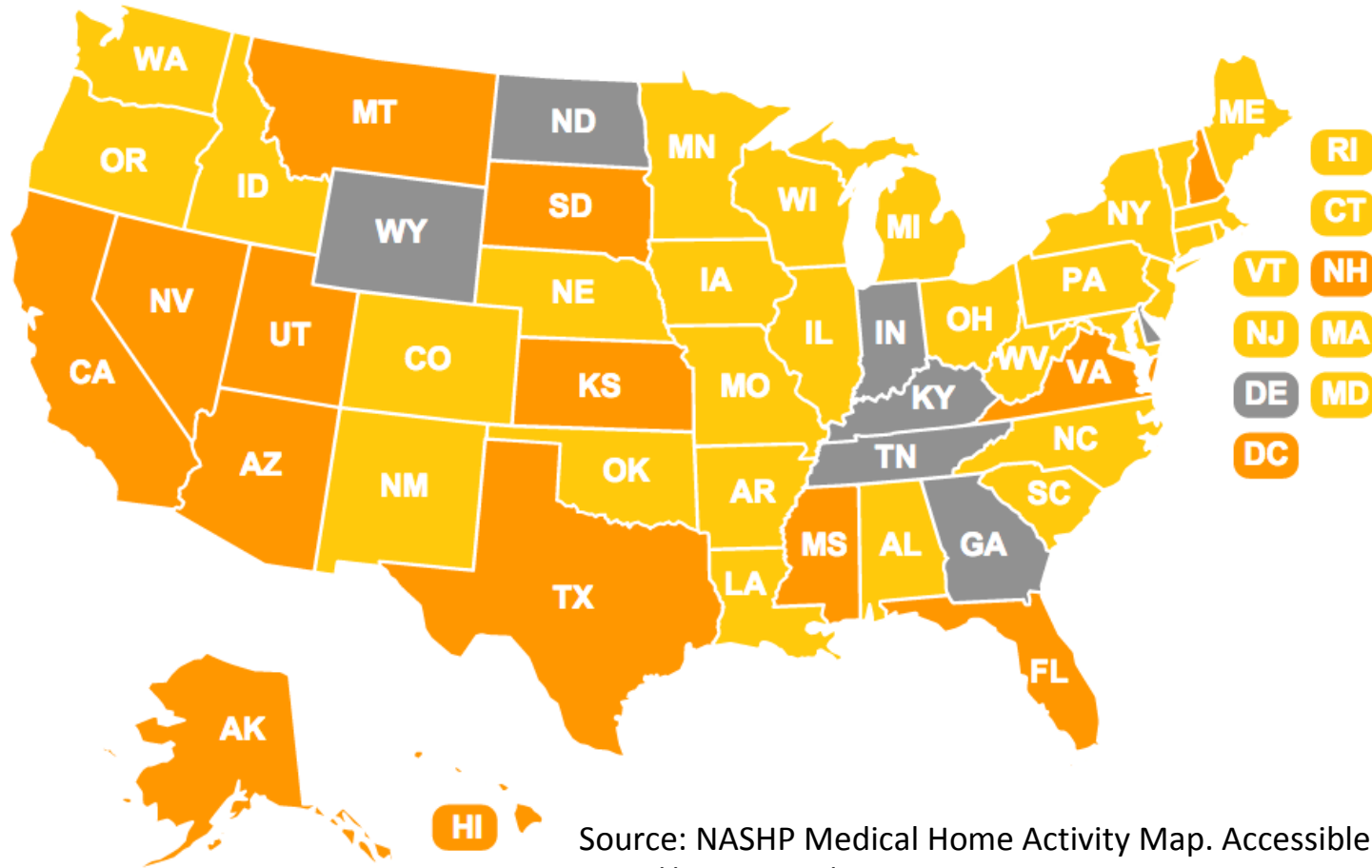
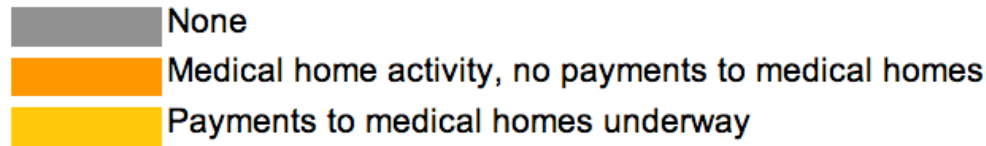
Non-Payment

- Medicaid policy
 - 11 states with Medicaid non-payment policies as of 2009 (Rosenthal and Hanlon 2009)
- Many state policies encompass other payers

Patient-Centered Medical Homes

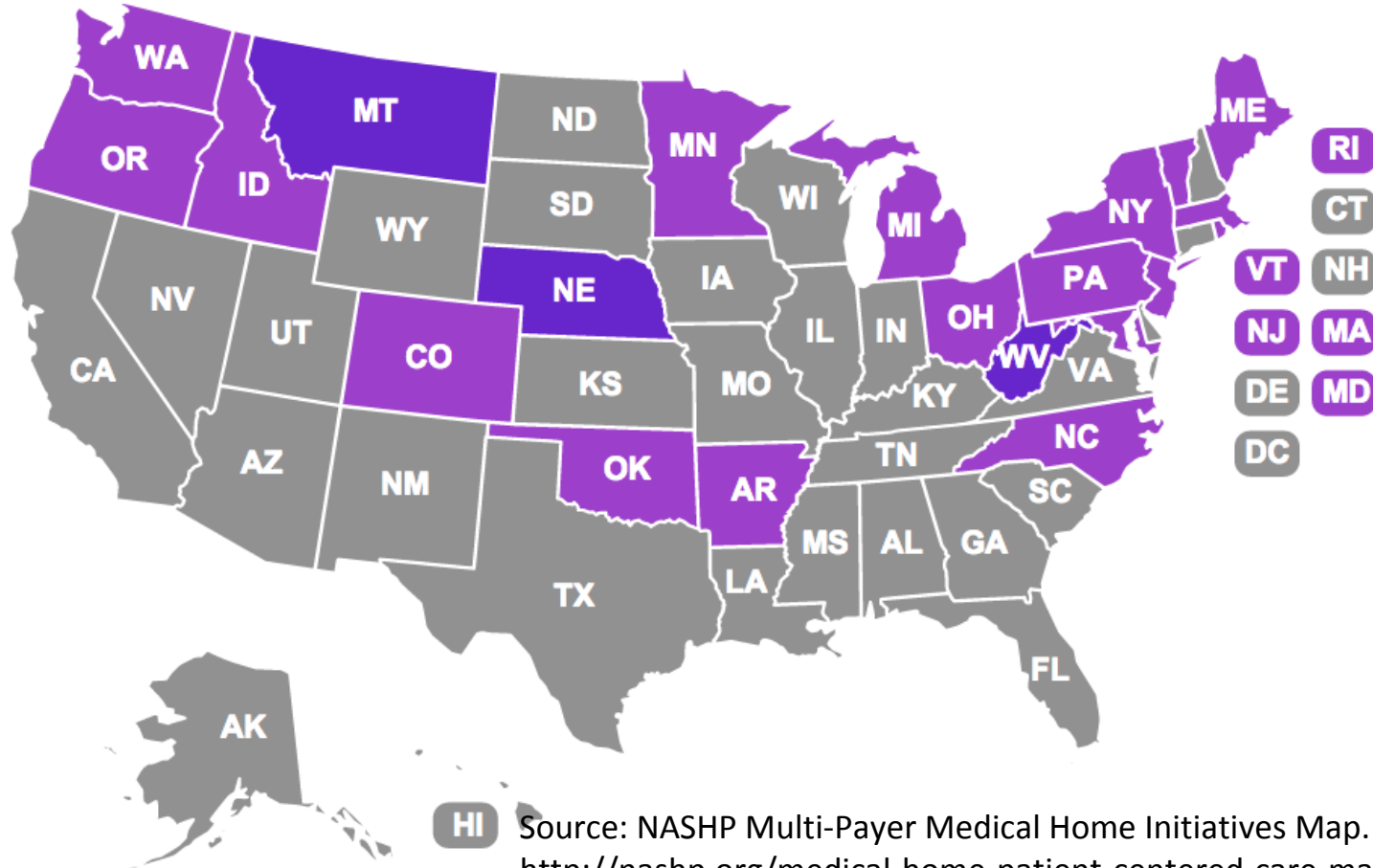
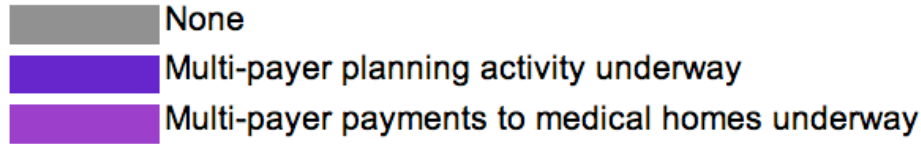
- Vast majority of states - 41 as of 2011 (Kaye, Buxbaum, Takach 2011)
- Highly variable payment approaches
- Pay for structure and process and (much less frequently) outcomes
