

Share of the U.S. Privately Insured Population with Access to Patient-Targeted Price Transparency Tool










- State by State Issue







Will Price Transparency Work?






The Transparency Puzzle

- Above market prices arise not just from a lack of price transparency, but also from significant provider power in negotiating fees.
- Viable solutions must:
 - Break down existing market leverage
 - Implement price transparency measures aimed at disclosing both price and quality information


