What is CPC?



- Multi-payer initiative fostering collaboration
 - Public and private health care payers
 - Goal is to strengthen primary care
- Medicare bonus payments to primary care doctors who better coordinate care

What is CPC?



- Selected primary care practices are provided tools and resources to better coordinate primary care
- THC regularly convenes Cincinnati/Dayton/ Northern Kentucky participants and supports 75 participating regional practices

Regional Strategy



Data Transparency

- Monthly CPC Champions meeting
 - Highlight practices with consistent improvements
 - Share successes and challenges across boundaries
 - Open forum for collaboration and networking
 - Provider engagement

Practice-Level Strategy



- Regional affinity groups
- Site visits or check-in calls
- Assess progress using combination of quarterly data
- Connect consistent improvers with those needing support
 - Both within system/group and across boundaries
- Targeted action plans created for low performers
- Practice run charts & patient-level data file reports

Required Regional Activities



All-Day Learning Sessions

- Data-driven
- Highlight high performers and foster peer-to-peer mentoring
- Breakouts to cover topics by role and across the care team
- Engagement

Process Measures/ Milestones 1-4



- Milestone #1: Budget
- Milestone #2: Provide care management for high-risk patients
- Milestone #3: 24/7 Access to medical record and continuity
- Milestone #4: Assess and improve patient experience of care

Process Measures/ Milestones 5-9



- Milestone #5: Data-driven quality improvement
- Milestone #6: Coordination across the medical neighborhood
- Milestone #7: Shared decision making
- Milestone #8: Participation in the Learning Collaborative
- Milestone #9: Health information technology
