What are CHCs?

Mission:

 To provide high quality, comprehensive and affordable health care that is coordinated, culturally and linguistically competent, and community directed for all medically underserved people

What are CHCs?


- Not-for-profit community-based practices with user majority governance
- Comprehensive range of primary care and preventive services for all life cycles
- Located in designated medically underserved areas (urban and rural)
- Convenient day, evening & weekend hours
- Open to all regardless of ability to pay

What are CHCs?

- aka FQHCs (Federally Qualified Health Centers); receive limited Federal grant support to subsidize uninsured
- 1150 CHCs with over 6300 sites serving over 17 million people (urban & rural), 40% uninsured, 37% Medicaid/SCHIP: the largest primary care safety net system in the US

Quality Management in CHCs

- Long history since Table 5 BCRR (1978)
- Patient Satisfaction Surveys Annually (mid 80's)
- Clinical Outcomes Measures (late 80's)
 - Many became HEDIS clinical measures
- Quality Improvement Plans Annual grant requirement (since early 90's)
- Joint Commission Accreditation

CHC Experience with Health Disparities

- Health Disparities Collaboratives (since '98):
 - Diabetes
 - Asthma
 - Depression
 - Prenatal care

- Cancer
- Cardiovascular
- Prevention
- Redesign

- Outcomes:
 - Studies consistently show performance levels equal to or greater than academic health centers

NACHC P4P Initiative

1. P4P Workgroup created 2006 (Joint recommendation of Health Policy Committee & Clinical Committee of Board)

2. Charge:

- Assess P4P environment (M'care & M'caid)
- Survey PCAs & Affiliated Health Plans (ACAP)
- Develop strategy to prepare CHCs & PCAs for P4P

3. Progress:

- Completed surveys: States, PCAs, Health Plans
- Developed linkages: AQA, NQF, PCPCC
- 4. "Quality Center" launched Dec 07 as focal point
