

Aim for **simplicity**


Redesign in areas with the **highest impact**; adopt existing process & capabilities in others

Integration Framework - Areas of Focus and Key Findings

Preserve Business Continuity through People, Process, and Technology



PEOPLE

- **Be Inclusive:** Partner and collaborate with relevant stakeholders across both companies to build agile integration sub-teams
- Engage Leadership: Empower leaders throughout the organization with clear accountability and decision rights
- Share Information: Provide clear, transparent communication about future organization alignment to the relevant workforce

PROCESS

- Keep It Simple: Redesign processes in high impact areas and leverage existing capabilities when possible
- Be Thorough: Co-create comprehensive Day 1 guidance to preserve business continuity
- Stay Agile: Prepare integration roadmaps while being mindful that timelines can change

TECHNOLOGY

- Prioritize Access: Identify who needs system access and when
- Determine End-State Solutions: Define which applications will be retained or decommissioned
- Stay Informed: Align with IT to understand integration timelines for relevant systems
