




The Life Expectancy of the Fee-for-Service Payment System is Relatively Short




High Cost Migrations




Medium Cost Transitions




Low Cost Transitions








Proactive vs. Reactive Models: Maximize Value



Neither chronic disease nor clinical risks alone are sufficient for predicting short-term costs




