#### Why Audit – Why Now

- Examining the process for audit we find:
  - On-going audit process creates sustainable success
  - Auditing control points allows for early detection of concerns that will be magnified upon claim submission
  - Allows for identification of patters and compliance risks
  - Universally accepted but seldom implemented in the US
    - Why ?




#### **National Health Service (NHS) Cycle**

- While NHS is not auditing reimbursement as much as quality their audit cycle will demonstrate how the US will move under the ACA
- This process demonstrates 5 elements that are very similar and are applicable to the revenue integrity program in most facilities
  - Note the elements of this audit cycle, while more broad are very similar to that of a totally unrelated field (Natural Gas)

#### **Standards**

- In order to audit there must be a written published standard
  - Unfortunately most hospitals standards are unpublished and passed from generation to generation
  - This failure to have written standards and audit against them is a major cause of revenue loss
  - If you don't have a standard then there is no control point
  - A control point with published standards must be present at each step in the revenue cycle in order to achieve revenue integrity
  - In the next slides we will illuminate each of the control points to consider




#### **Base Healthcare Revenue Cycle**






## **Base Healthcare Revenue Cycle - Audit**






## **Base Healthcare Revenue Integrity Cycle**
