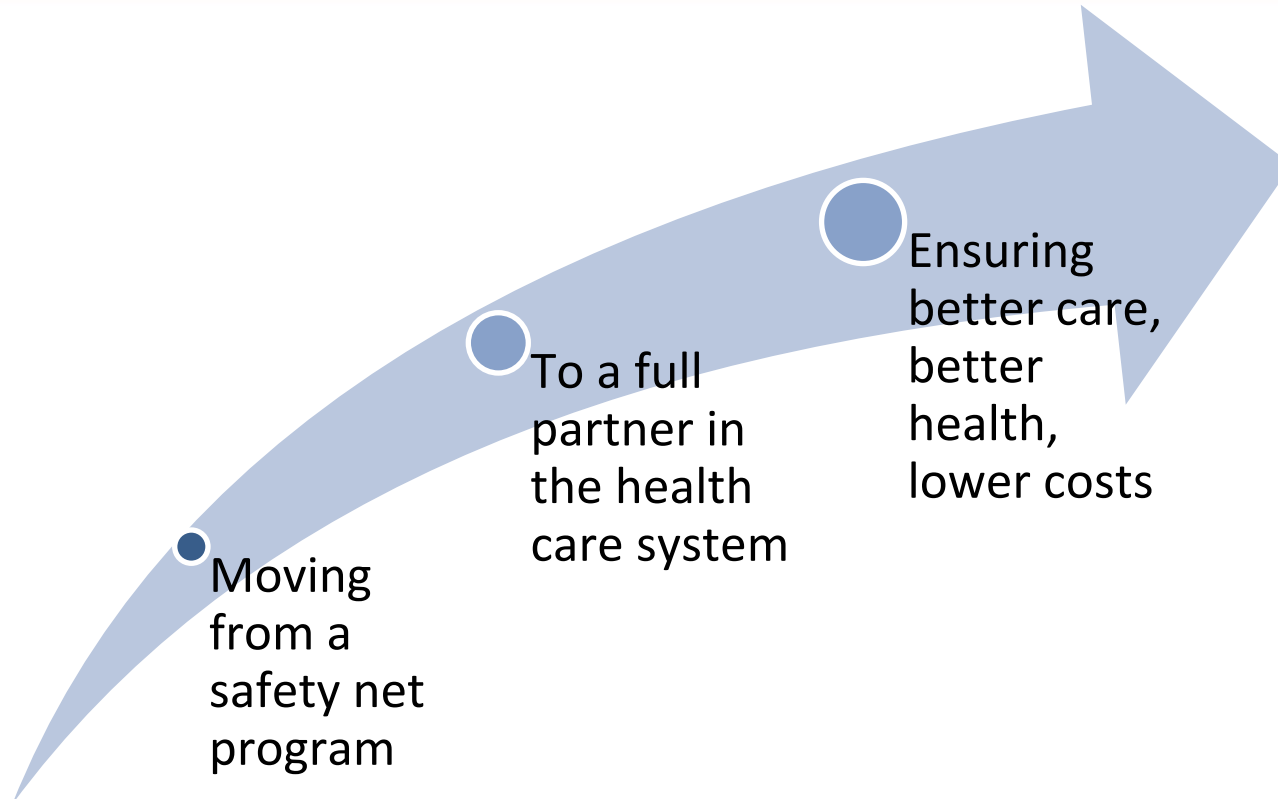

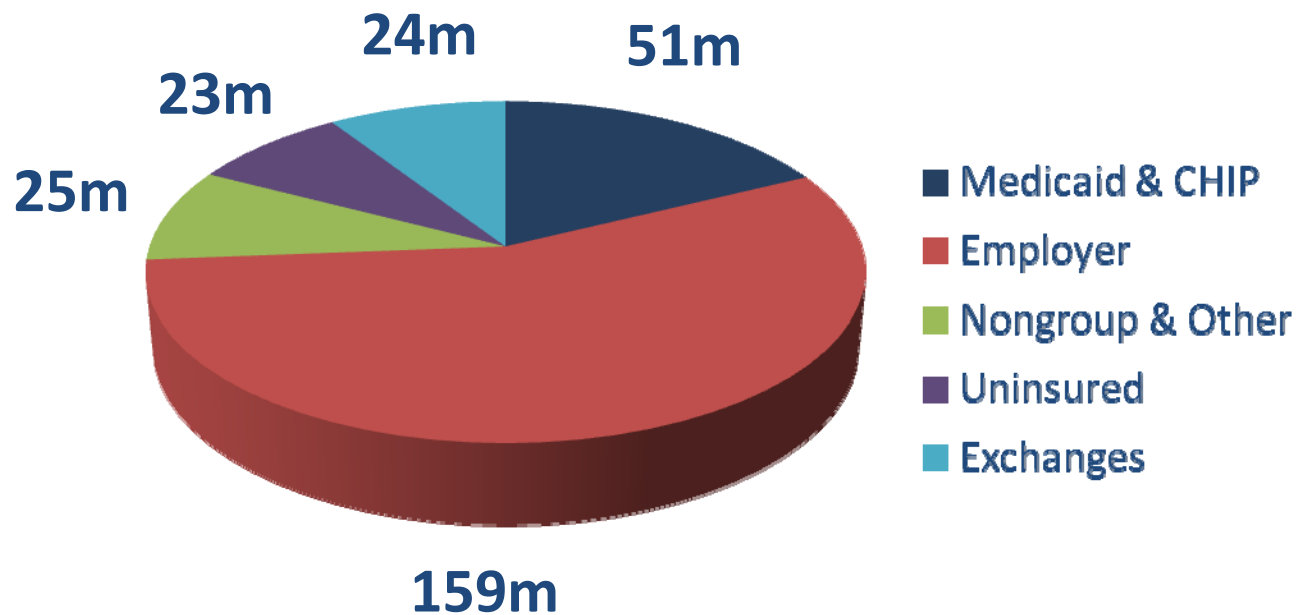

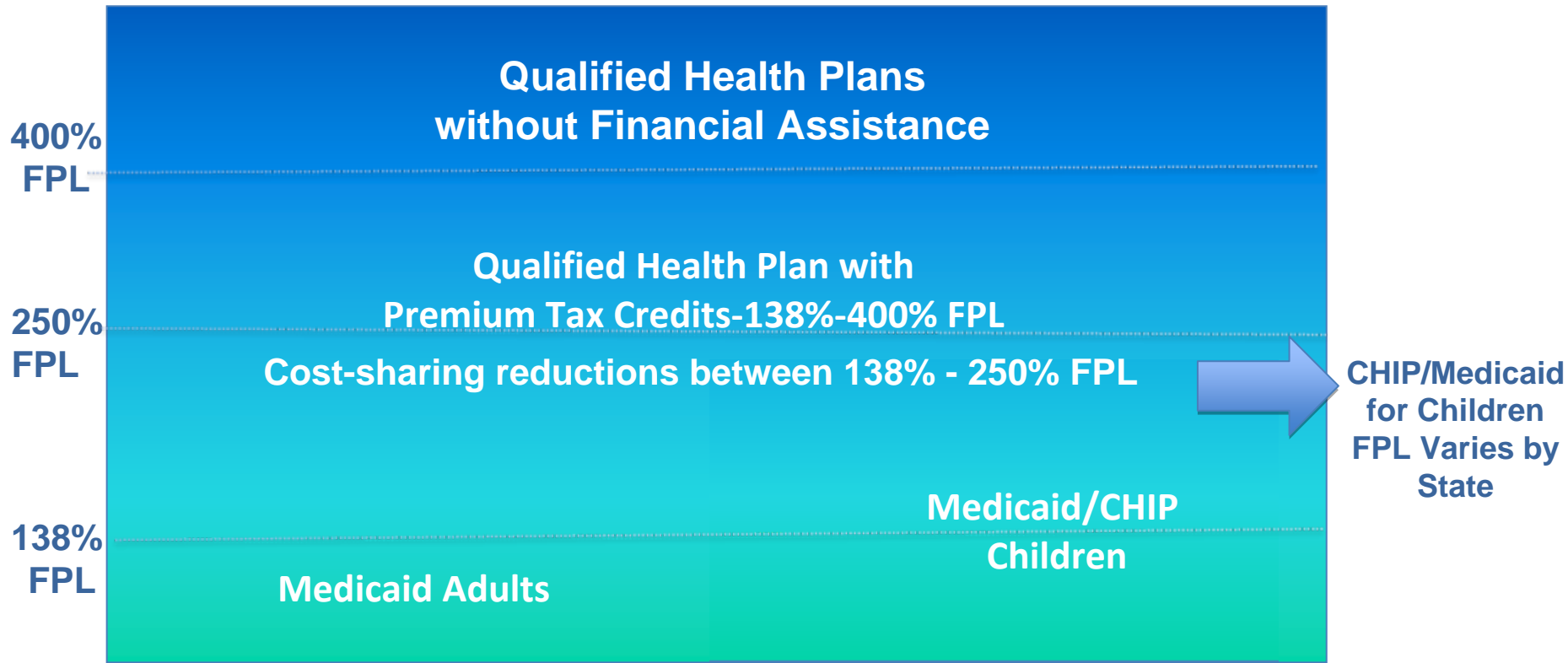

## Policy Guidance

- ❖ Fundamental revamping of eligibility, enrollment, renewal
- ❖ Eligible = Enrolled
- ❖ Coordination with Exchange

# Seamless, Streamlined Eligibility and Enrollment

Submit single, application to the Exchange

- Online
- Phone
- Mail
- In Person

Verify and assess or determine eligibility

- Supported by data services hub
- Eligibility for:
  - Qualified health plans (QHPs)
  - QHPs with tax credits and cost-sharing reductions
  - Medicaid and CHIP
  - BHP

Enroll in coverage

- Enrollment in a QHP or Medicaid/CHIP
- Online plan comparison tool available to inform QHP selection
- Advance payment of the premium tax credit is transferred to the QHP

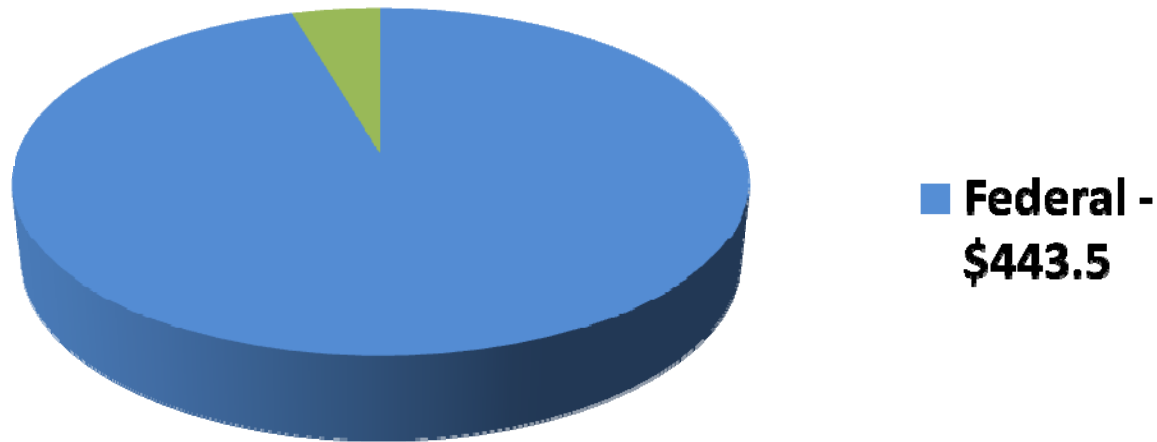

## Systems Development

- ❖ 90% federal funding for IT Systems development (eligibility until December 31, 2015) and 75% for maintenance (ongoing)
- ❖ 46 states have approved or pending APDs

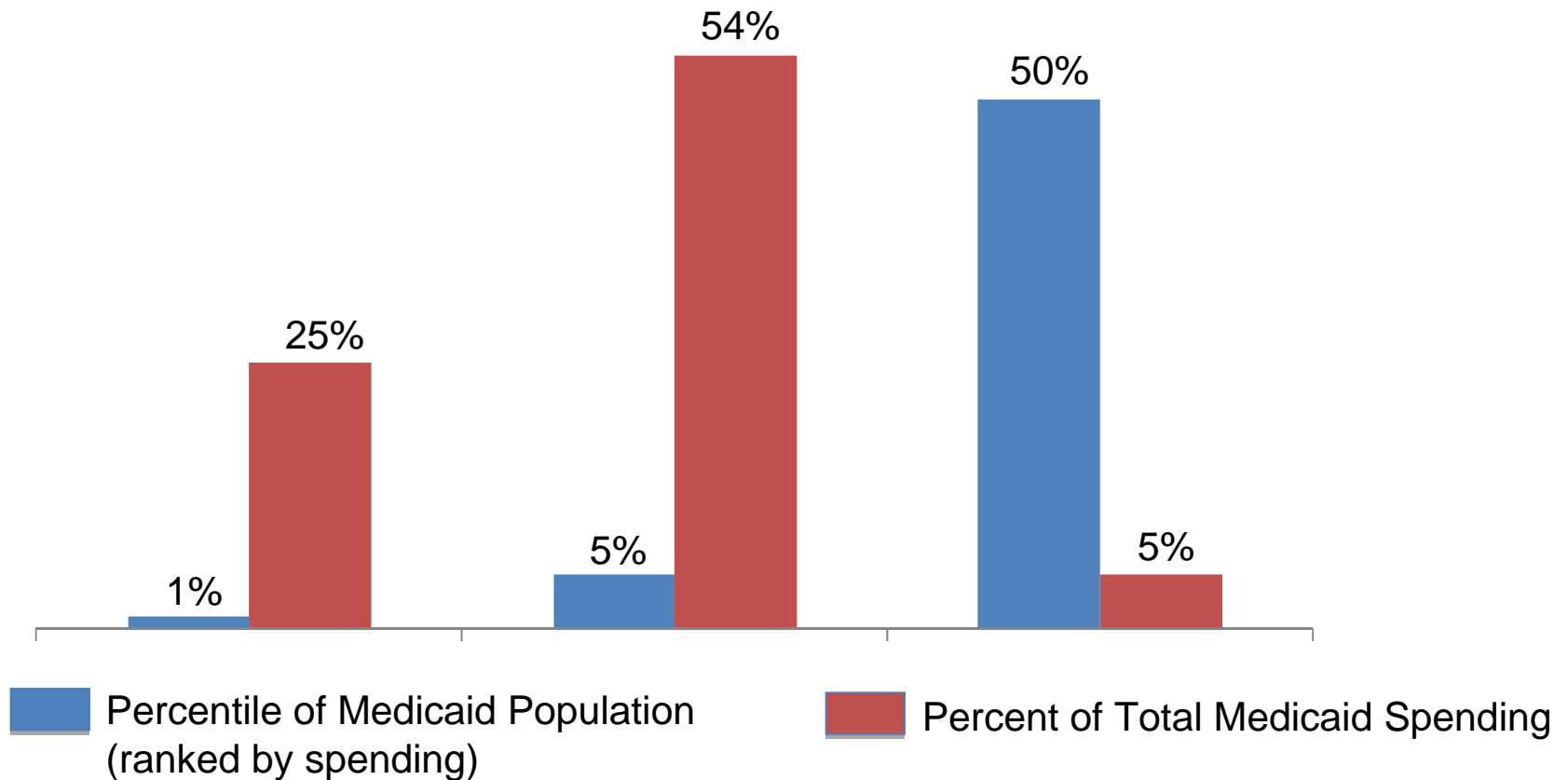

# Concentration of Medicaid Spending



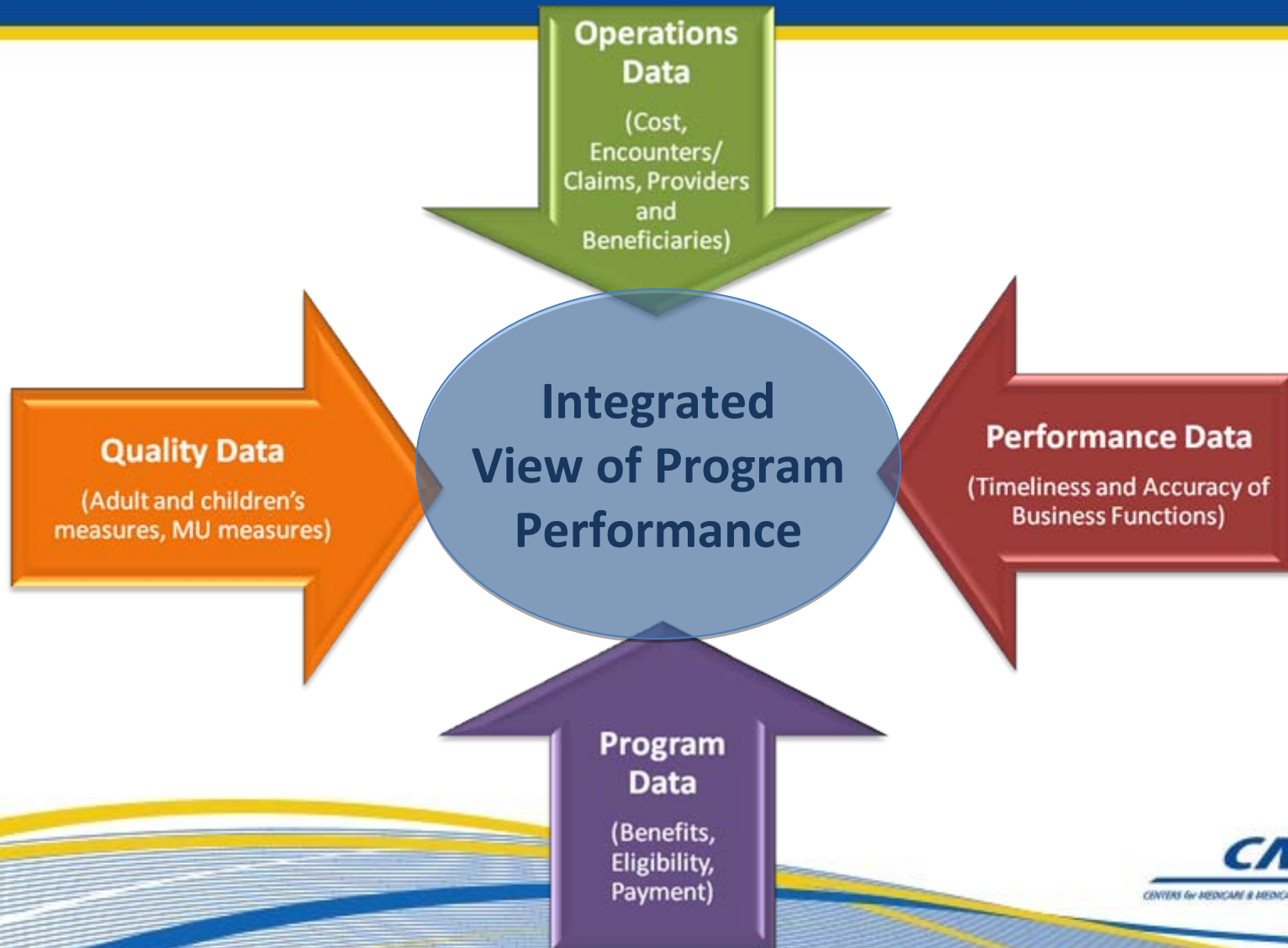

# States Moving Forward

- ❖ 27 States have approved or pending health home SPAs or planning grants
  - ❖ 46 States have approved or pending APDs for E and E systems
  - ❖ States as diverse as California, Texas and Massachusetts have delivery system transformation waivers
  - ❖ North Carolina has Community Care Networks and Oregon is establishing Community Care Organizations
  - ❖ Utah has adopted electronic notices
  - ❖ Louisiana has streamlined its renewal process to substantially reduce use of paper renewal forms
  - ❖ Tennessee is exploring Medicaid/Exchange Bridge Plans
  - ❖ Arkansas is developing episode-based payments
  - ❖ Camden New Jersey is hot spotting high cost cases through a community-accountable care delivery system
  - ❖ Connecticut, DC, and Minnesota have adopted the early coverage option for childless adults; Six States have new waivers to do so
  - ❖ Massachusetts has an approved asthma prevention demonstration
  - ❖ 39 states have paid than \$1.2B in Medicaid HIT incentive payment to providers in their States
